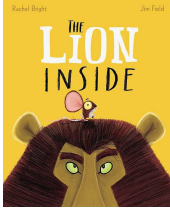

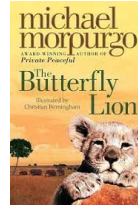

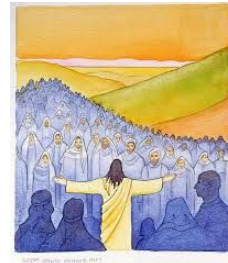
Maths

We are exploring artwork typical of some indigenous African groups, including necklaces from the Masai indigenous group and masks from the Chewa indigenous group.



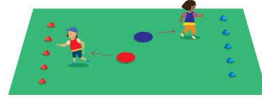
Computing
