



## Communication and Language Literacy

Our English text this term is the beautiful 'The Sea Saw' By Tom Percival. There will be lots of opportunities for the children to listen and respond to the text making comments or asking questions. There will also be a variety of writing opportunities with modelled writes leading into independent tasks. By the end of the unit the children will attempt to rewrite the story in their own words. The focus will be on structuring simple sentences with basic punctuation.

In Phonics we will continue to learn the level 3 sounds and the level 4 and 5 helpful words.

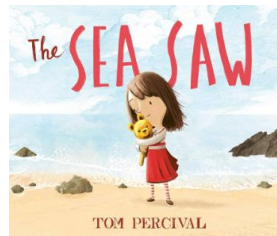

### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Our focus this term will be the transition into Year 1.



### Maths

- Pupils will consolidate their counting skills, counting to larger numbers and developing a wider range of counting strategies. They will also continue to develop a sense of magnitude, e.g. knowing that 8 is quite a lot more than 2, but 4 is only a little bit more than 2
- They will begin to generalise about 'one more than' and 'one less than' numbers within 10.
- They will also continue to explore 2D and 3D shapes as well as play with more complex patterns.





# Learning Overview

## Bumblebees Term 6

### Oh I do like to be beside the seaside!

#### Understanding of the World

We will be comparing High Halden to Hastings. We will look at the features of Hastings as a coastal town and compare them to High Halden.

We will focus on the different habitats at the seaside and which animals and plants live in them.

Additionally during this term we look at the change from Spring to Summer. Each season we have gone on the same walk through the fields behind the church looking at what has changed since we were last there.

#### Physical Development

We are lucky enough to have a hockey coach who will be teaching them on Mondays. On Fridays the children will be taking part in some athletics coaching.

#### RE

Which stories are special and why?  
We will look at stories linked to different faiths and the children will learn why they are special to people from a variety of faiths.

#### D&T

In D&T this term we will be learning how to safely use knives to cut some soft fruit and vegetables. We'll learn the bridge hold and the claw grip.

#### Computing

In computing we will introduce the idea of data handling. We'll be sorting and categorising, responding to yes/no questions and interpreting pictograms.
