arable farm - a farm that grows **crops** such as wheat and barley.



livestock farm - a farm that **rears animals** for their products such as meat, eggs, wool or milk.



reared - Care for and bring up children or young animals.

crops - Plants that are grown in large amounts for food.



agriculture - another word for farming.



barn - A building on a farm that houses animals or goods.



field - A place where farmers can grow crops or keep animals.

Seasons

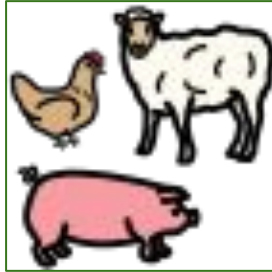
One of the four main parts of the year; The seasons are Spring, Summer, Autumn and Winter.

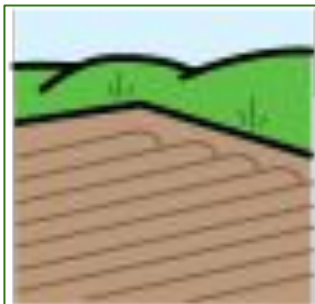
