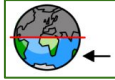


Vocabulary

The Amazon rainforest is the world's largest tropical rainforest and it covers 40% of South America, across 9 countries. It is also home to 10% of all known species on earth!

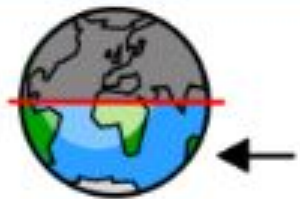
**Rio De Janeiro**

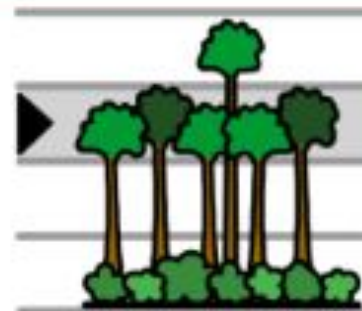
